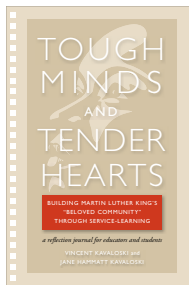
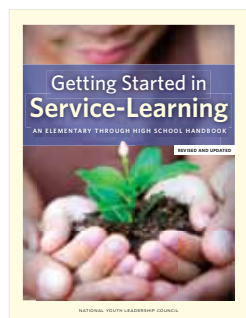

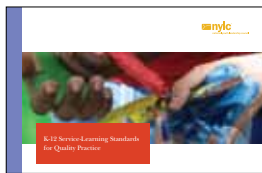
Tough Minds and Tender Hearts: A Reflection Journal

Readers come to understand seminal people, readings, and periods of his life that led to some of his most memorable speeches. Sets of reflection questions follow each chapter and take the reader first back to the text, then to connections with individual experiences. A range of writing prompts and suggestions for reflection through drawing and other forms of expression are included. Suitable for high school-age students through adults. 55 pages; paperback.
